IJB TRAVEL POLICY

Report by Chief Officer, Health and Social Care

PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. To agree and publish the travel policy of the Integration Joint Board.

COMPETENCE

2. The issues raised in the report are purely procedural. Expenses will be allocated to a general management funding line within the IJB.

SUMMARY

3. The need to develop a travel policy was suggested by the Chair of the IJB following several challenges in connecting the VC from Uist and Barra. The IJB has consistently operated on the basis of inclusion and it is therefore proposed that the IJB should support members to attend IJB meetings or other appropriate events who are unable to fund travel and accommodation. The policy therefore focuses on IJB members who are not supported by the two statutory bodies: NHS Western Isles and the Comhairle.
4. In view of the fact that the IJB represents the whole of the Western Isles, consideration might also be given to taking one meeting a year to an alternative venue.

RECOMMENDATIONS

5. It is recommended that the IJB:
 - (a) Agrees to the content of the IJB travel policy, and
 - (b) Agrees that it takes immediate effect.
