6	Full text of direction	<p>NHS Western Isles should develop a hub and outreach model for the delivery of dental services in Uist;</p> <p>Until the new model can be implemented and capital works completed, the Lochmaddy and Lionacleit Clinics should continue in operation;</p> <p>A transition and implementation plan should be devised by the Chief Officer and Director of Dental Services for implementation by the Health Board and with appropriate strategic oversight by the IJB, to give effect to the new model;</p> <p>The transition and implementation plan should include timelines for review and should take account of the recommendations of the EQIA, which focus on the needs of frail older and disabled people. It is expected that the outreach service described within the implementation plan will prioritise these population groups, with a particular focus on South Uist and Eriskay while the hub is in development.</p>
